# 2019 FAE Fall Forum Course Descriptions

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 15, 2019

9 am-12 pm Expanding Role of Vital Pulp Therapy (3 CE), Martin Trope, DMD

**Fully Sponsored by Brasseler USA**

It is indisputable that maintaining a vital healthy pulp is the best way to prevent apical periodontitis; however, treatment protocols available for vital pulp therapy are extremely limited, and at present the best treatment for a carious exposure is a full pulpectomy. New materials and knowledge give some hope to expanding the role of vital pulp therapy to include cases where we previously thought it to be impossible. In this lecture, Dr. Trope discusses the biological indications for indirect pulp capping, direct pulp capping, pulpotomy, and pulp regeneration. Attendees learn the reaction of the pulp to stimuli, especially a carious exposure; strategies to use this knowledge to plan successful vital pulp therapy; and future procedures that will regenerate new pulp into spaces where it was previously lost.

The XP family of endodontic instruments has been modeled to achieve a fusion of technology and biology that integrates all variables essential for predictable endodontic success. The superelasticity and shape-memory of the alloy used in XP instruments facilitates expansion and adaptation into canal morphology where traditional in-the-round NiTi files are unable to reach with any margin of safety. This enables maximal debridement and disinfection without changes to the original canal shape and ensures minimal removal of intra-canal dentin. This ultra-conservative root treatment can then be filled using bioceramic technologies that do not require excessive preparation in the coronal component of the root canal space to accommodate obturation procedures. In this lecture, attendees comprehend the scientifically based biologic requirements for endodontic success; understand the limitations of files that creates a round shape; and discover the latest generation of technologies that allow us to clinically obtain the essential biologic goals for success.

During this session, Dr. Limosani provides insight into modern day treatment planning and execution philosophies that revolve around providing long lasting patient centered outcomes. Participants review clinical techniques, as well as the integration of new technology that are aimed at minimizing the collateral damage inflicted when attempting to accomplish endodontic goals. After the session, participants are able to identify the shift in treatment philosophy that comes with this modern day approach, as well as better understand how the most recent advancements in endodontics can allow for treatment of patients with techniques that translate to less unnecessary tooth structure loss.
