2023 FAE Fall Forum Speaker Program

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 29

9 am-12 pm Interdisciplinary Endodontics, Part 1 | 3 CE | Rick S. Schwartz, DDS | During this two-part course, Dr. Schwartz conducts an interactive, case-based session on decision-making and treatment planning in endodontics. Emphasis is placed on the role of endodontics in multi-specialty care and how endodontic treatment can improve the outcomes in other areas of dentistry, including implants. Dr. Schwartz presents case histories and leads attendees through the thought process of diagnosis, case selection, endodontic and restorative considerations, and execution of treatment. He discusses the importance of the "patient conversation" and the use of "decision points" in treatment planning, his risk / benefit / cost analysis, and management of "special situations" such as resorption, trauma management, and root fractures. At the conclusion of this two part course (part two, 1:30-4:30 pm), participants should be able to discuss: management of a wide variety of everyday endodontic scenarios and some scenarios that are not so common; how the execution of the endodontic treatment influences the success or failure of the restorative treatment, and vice versa; a logical, organized approach to endodontic treatment planning and integrating it with other areas of dentistry; and the role of Cone Beam CT in one's practice.

12-1:30 pm Lunch & Learn: Laser Assisted Endodontics | 1 CE | Justin Kolnick, DDS | During this Lunch & Learn, attendees learn how laser-activated technology can allow for better disinfection and cleaning of root canals, ensuring more successful endodontic outcomes. *Speaker Sponsored By: Edge Endo.*

1:30-4:30 pm Interdisciplinary Endodontics, Part 2 | 3 CE | Rick S. Schwartz, DDS | This is the second part of this course; see course description above.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30

9 am-12 pm Interappointment Flare-ups: Incidence, Related Factors, Prevention & Treatment | 3 CE | Richard E. Walton, DMD, MS | Despite careful root canal treatment procedures, complications such as severe pain and / or swelling may occur post-appointment. There are many misconceptions regarding empiricisms related to the flare-up phenomenon. Incidence, prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and causative factors are not necessarily what are believed and practiced. Dr. Walton discusses these, based on biological information from the literature. Included is a rational approach toward the use of therapeutics, both to prevent and treat flare-ups.

1:30-3 pm Anesthetizing the Endodontic Patient: Why Such a Challenge | 1.5 CE | Richard E. Walton, DMD, MS | Anesthetizing the endodontic patient is often difficult. Topics covered include the inherent problems in attaining profound anesthesia (particularly with a pulpitis) and some proposed explanations. Also presented are alternative anesthetic techniques to enhance treatment, and some approaches that are helpful in delivering "painless" injections. Included in this session are a series of videos that demonstrate how-to techniques.

3:30-5 pm Endodontic-Periodontic Interrelationships | 1.5 CE | Richard E. Walton, DMD, MS | The pulp and periodontium are interactive, sharing communications and pathoses. Disease in one can impact the other, but to what extent? Dr. Walton discusses the anatomic relationships and how pulp and periodontal pathoses communicate, as well as the clinical implications. Included are the important considerations of often confusing diagnosis and treatment planning.

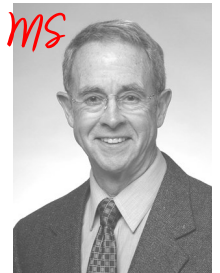


Rick S. Schwartz, DDS

Dr. Rick Schwartz was a restorative dentist for 19 years prior to entering post-graduate training in endodontics. He attended a two-year general dentistry residency, and then did a combination of private practice, teaching, and dental materials research before entering endodontic training in 1996. He has authored over 100 articles and abstracts and was a cover author on three editions of Fundamentals of Operative Dentistry by Quintessence Publishing Co. and Advanced Cone Beam CT for Endodontics. He is also first author of Best Practices in Endodontics, also from Quintessence. For the past 24 years he has been in full time practice limited to endodontics in San Antonio, Texas. He has lectured extensively in the US and in 18 other countries.

Richard E. Walton, DMD, MS

Dr. Richard Walton earned a DMD at the University of Oregon. After two years in the US Army, he earned a Certificate in Endodontics and an MS in Histology at the University of Illinois. Dr. Walton was faculty at the University of Connecticut and chair at the Medical College of Georgia. At the University of Iowa (UI) College of Dentistry, he has been professor and chair of endodontics, and is now Professor Emeritus. Dr. Walton has received awards from the UI College of Dentistry for his teaching and service; a UI Endowed Professorship was established in 2004 and the Endodontic Clinic carries his name. He was recognized by the AAE with the Grossman Research Award in 2003 and the IB Bender Lifetime Educator Award in 2015. Dr. Walton is a Diplomate of and was an examiner on the American Board of Endodontics.



Justin Kolnick, BDS

Dr. Justin Kolnick attended dental school at the University of the Witwatersrand in Johannesburg, South Africa and graduated from the postdoctoral endodontic program at Columbia University, New York. He entered into private practice limited to endodontics in White Plains, New York, expanded to Mount Kisco, and developed the first microendodontic practice in Westchester County. Dr. Kolnick has been associate clinical professor in endodontics at both Columbia University and New York Medical College, as well as an attending at Westchester Medical Center. A world authority on laser-assisted endodontics, Dr. Kolnick has published numerous articles on endodontics and lectures internationally.
